## A little bit of history...

The Red House Group originated in the early 1990's, when a group of local artists grouped together to promote art and craft in the City of Marion. A steering committee was formed, with members including Anne Thompson, Sandy Retallick, Billie Adams, Marlie Unmuth, Mary Landkroon, Hare Krishna Bag, Barbara Binns and Eddie Knuepfer. From this group, the Red House Group evolved, with its incorporation in 1994.

There were thirty five Foundation members who started the group in August of that year, and within a year over 130 artist had joined. Many of those are still active members today.

The group managed the Red House Gallery from 1994 - 2001, when the Red House Group was given the opportunity to manage Gallery M in the new Marion Cultural Centre.
