From the Co-ordinator

As another successful Red House member exhibition comes to its conclusion (try to get in before 18 March), several things need to be brought to your attention to make the handling and displaying of your work easier for all concerned.

If your work requires special handling - ie: collaged items or other delicate elements, please advise of this when delivering your work.

Also - Artist Statements that are displayed with your work MUST be received prior to delivery day. These statements have to be typed and laminated, and are prepared in advance of the exhibition change-over week. If you are not sure what you are exhibiting till after you lodge your entry form, send the details via e-mail or post.

Another 'housekeeping' matter - if you have payments owing from sold exhibition or shop artwork, please collect your cheque or cash (under \$10) from the gallery as soon as possible. Many artists have now opted to receive their payment via EFT to their nominated bank account - monthly statements of sold work can be picked up when you visit the gallery, or they will be sent in the next available mail-out.

The next exhibition will be a bit of fun - make sure you bring the kids along to see the art vehicles on display.

MARION LEARNING FESTIVAL

In August, Westfield Marion and other venues including the Marion Cultural Centre, will be the hub of community interactive learning as people of all ages get the opportunity to observe and participate in new activities.

'LIVE & LOCAL' ARTISTS

Flinders Universities Student Council is hoping to hold a campaign for "Live and Local Artists" during May. There will be stalls situated in the plaza area on main campus, and hopes that the students, whether current or past, will be able to bring their work to exhibit.

They are looking for public artists to come to present and sell their work on the day. This includes musicians who want to sell CDs and merchandise, potters with their work, sculptors, jewellers, painters, writers etc. There will be stalls available. During the day on the plaza it will be like a market, and include buskers, which could of course be of any kind (i.e. musicians, performers etc) positioned around the campus.

Also wanted are stall holders who can bring some of their local produce, and also crafts that they will be willing to sell on the day; this might include homemade soaps, candles, juices, cakes, etc.
