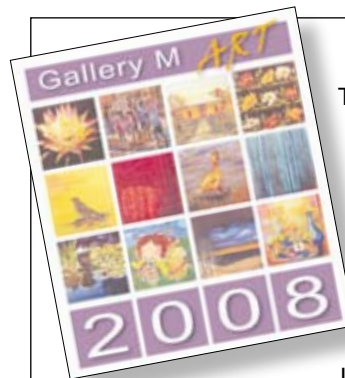
### Artist Talk & Demonstration
