2008 CRAFTSOUTH YOUTH CRAFT MENTORSHIP

Craftsouth is calling for applications from South Australia's young and emerging craft and design practitioners to undertake a three-month mentorship, valued at \$9,000, with an established practitioner of their choice. Practitioners who are aged 30 years and under are eligible to apply.

Applicants are invited to select a mentor and develop a program of activity spanning a three-month period to conclude by 31 December 2008.

The mentorship provides an opportunity to explore new artistic directions, to expand technical skills and increase knowledge of business practice. The mentorship may be largely skills focused, however, applicants are encouraged to develop a program which incorporates business skills development as well as the investigation and development of new market opportunities such as: product launches, private commissions, public art commissions, development of a website, or exhibitions with local and interstate galleries.
