The title 'XIV' recognises that this is the fourteenth year of the Red House Group, which was incorporated in 1994. It is not a theme - so artwork does not have to relate specifically to the title.

However, as this artwork will be reproduced in the 2009 promotional calendar, **ALL ARTWORK MUST BE OF A SQUARE FORMAT**, no more than one metre wide (including frame).

The total number of artworks will be 60, to ensure every piece is represented in the calendar - get your entry forms in quickly, as once 60 entries have been processed no more will be accepted.
