From the Co-ordinator

Hi fellow Red House members - Happy New Year to you all.

We kick off 2010 at Gallery M with a whole gallery exhibition of Red House member artwork - ninety of you are showcasing your efforts in what promises to be a spectacular display.

**Delivery day is Tuesday 12 January** - if you are in this exhibition your Consignment Agreement and labels are enclosed in this mail-out.

If you missed the chance to be in this exhibition, there will be two more opportunities later in the year: 11 June - 4 July, and 29 October - 19 November. Entry forms for these exhibitions will be sent out several months before the exhibition periods - places are keenly sought, so remember to pay your entry fee and return your forms as soon as possible.

#### Shop stock needed

We had great sales in the Gallery M shop during December - over \$5,500 - so some of the displays are looking decidedly bare. If you are a regular exhibitor, please bring new stock in as soon as possible. We are also looking for fresh new innovative items to sell - especially from new artists working in all media. Gift items suitable for weddings, birthdays and special occasions are also needed. The only items we don't need at present are greeting cards, as our displays are bursting at the seams. The shop commission rate is a low 22%, with no obligation to volunteer in the shop.

Of course, our volunteers continue to play a valuable role in the operation of Gallery M, and I would like to thank everyone who made a contribution during the past year. If you would like to become involved in 2010, call in and have a chat with us.

Helping out is as simple as putting your name into our Volunteer Roster - allocated shifts are from 10am-1pm, or 1pm-4pm. There is always a paid staff member on duty, so you don't have to do anything you are unsure about.

Thanks to all artists who created special stock with a Christmas theme - all unsold Christmas stock has been placed in the storeroom for collection. Please pick it up next time you visit Gallery M.
