From the Co-ordinator

I hope you are all enjoying the return of some warmer weather; it always inspires me to get more creative once the winter months are ending.

The new exhibition at Gallery M opens on Friday 1 October, and features the artwork of five artists who collectively call themselves 'Four Birds & a Bloke'. It will be a very lively exhibition of high standard work, so I hope you all get the chance to come along, either to the opening night or before the close of the exhibition on 24 October.

The following exhibition period includes a half gallery Red House member exhibition - 'The Art of Giving'. Entries have been coming in steadily, so if you want to be included, get your entry form and \$10 fee in to Gallery M as soon as possible, before the quota is reached. The difference about this exhibition is that purchased work can be taken from the gallery before the close of the exhibition; and artists can replace that item without any extra cost. The catch? All items have to be priced at \$250 or less.

The new Board, elected at the recent AGM, have had their first meeting, and have immediately got on with the business of managing Gallery M. One of the items discussed was a review of the criteria for acceptance of work into the Gallery M shop, and this will take place over the coming months. Some artwork that is currently on display may no longer be suitable, but artists will also have clear set of guidelines to follow.

We are also looking at the way this Red House Group newsletter is produced and distributed. For artists wanting to promote an exhibition or event, there will be a new page on the Gallery M website, where you can upload your information and it will be available to view much sooner than waiting for the newsletter to be published. We are also hoping that the task of creating the newsletter can be taken on by a Red House member. So there may be a different look, but we will still ensure you are kept informed of Red House and member activities on a regular basis.
