NEW ARTS VENTURE AT BRIGHTON

Cabin453 is about being creative, being adventurous and taking a leap into the unknown. It is about going on a journey, trying something artistic, even something new.

At **Cabin453** students at all levels, from small children to older adults are encouraged.

There is a focus at Cabin453 upon student centred learning, and classes reflect this by being tailored around the learning needs and creative interests of individual students. Classes are available weekdays, afterschool, evenings and Saturdays, while during the school holidays exciting workshops are available to cure the Cabin Fever that afflicts all families at those times.

Other activities include the studios of local artists who are busy developing ideas and making original work. Cabin453 also has a large exhibition space which caters for changing exhibitions of local artists work. In December 2010 an Artist's Market was also held which allowed the local community to meet, chat with and purchase local artists work.
